

KAKADU NATIONAL PARK EXTENDED FISHING TOUR

Location

Kakadu National Park, approximately 220km east of Darwin.

Target Species

Barramundi, but you can also target Jewfish, Golden Snapper, Salmon and Saratoga.

What to expect

Kakadu National Park offers you varied fishing options, all options can be part of an extended tour dependant on tides and conditions at the time of your trip.

When the tides permit you will travel to the mouth of the South Alligator River chasing Barra and hard fighting Jew Fish and Golden Snapper.

Run Off fishing can continue through to late May on a good year providing the opportunity to head upstream and fish the colour changes and rock bars for Barramundi.

With several Billabongs accessible within the park or several closer to Darwin, fishing these picturesque billabongs is also another great option available.

Minimum numbers

Minimum of two is required.

Availability

May – November

Transfers

You will be collected from your Darwin accommodation before sunrise and will be transferred to the South Alligator River, Kakadu National Park in an air-conditioned late model 4wd. On the final day, you will be returned to your accommodation by approx 5pm.

Accommodation

Aurora Kakadu Resort, air-conditioned rooms, in-ground pool, Bar and Restaurant, this is an ideal base.

Options

This tour is available from three to 5 days

Included

- Transfers in luxury four-wheel drive
- All fishing gear supplied on a replace if lost or damaged basis
- Lunches, cooked breakfasts and dinners (except breakfast day 1 and dinner on the final day)
- Light refreshments
- special dietary requirements catered for
