### **Getting there**

A 50 minute flight from Darwin and you will be greeted with the sight of a maze of mangrove lined estuaries and several islands. Your aircraft will land on one of these islands and then it's just a five minute walk to your accommodation.

### **The Camp**

Permanent tropical friendly tents with comfortable bedding, designed to catch the sea breezes will ensure a good nights sleep after a hard days fishing and a meal of Barra and mud crabs. Fresh water showers and septic toilets are a welcomed luxury for a remote camp.



### **Meals**

The camp has a large kitchen/dining area with fans, 240 volt power supply, ample fridges and freezers. Just because you are in the middle of no where doesn't mean you have to miss out on a good feed, Mud Crab and Barra are always on offer and you will also be pleased with great BBQ meals and roast dinners. Make sure you get Stenny to whip up some of his famous beer battered Barra.



### **The Fishing**

Usually Barramundi is the prime target for fisherman. The blue water scene provides the angler with the opportunity to cast feeding schools of pelagic fish. All our safari boats are 5.5 metre to 6 metres in length and run 4-stroke environmentally friendly outboards. The Boats are built to government regulations. Our professional guides are fully accredited with many years of experience fishing the tropical waterways of the Northern Territory

## THE TOUR

**Duration:** 3 to 7 days

**Departure:** By arrangement from March to early December. Weather permitting.  
( Flying in / out to maximise fishing time)

You will be met at Darwin Airport and transferred to the light aircraft section for your 50 minute flight. Settle into camp and enjoy a lovely dinner of local seafood and discuss your fishing with a guide for the remainder of your stay.

On the last day your departure for Darwin will depend on the Tide. If departing from the Island it is usually approx. 2 p.m.

(Can fly one way and drive the other)

Fully screened, fan cooled sleeping huts, all linen  
Highly recommended and experienced guides  
All fish surplus to needs are released

**Exclusions:** Alcohol and soft drinks, must be pre ordered.  
Domestic Travel to and from Darwin.  
Accommodation and meals whilst in Darwin.  
Tackle supplied on a replace if lost or damaged basis.  
Fly fishing tackle is not supplied  
Return flights to our camp

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- Minimum:** 2 angler's minimum - 3 angler's maximum per boat  
Larger groups of up to 12 anglers can be catered for.
- Lure fishing is our speciality, your guide will instruct you on how to use all our tackle, and will have you catching fish in no time, casting to fallen trees, submerged snags, gutters, creek junctions or trolling around reef areas and deeper water rock bars in rivers and coastal regions.
- What to Bring** Towel, sunscreen, shady hat, insect repellent, toiletries, medications you may need, torch, camera and film. Clothing - light and comfortable, long trousers are advisable and sandals or teva's.
- Baggage Limit** Please keep baggage to a maximum of 5kgs. Soft-sided sports bags are best. Excess baggage will be charged at \$3.00 per/k.

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
